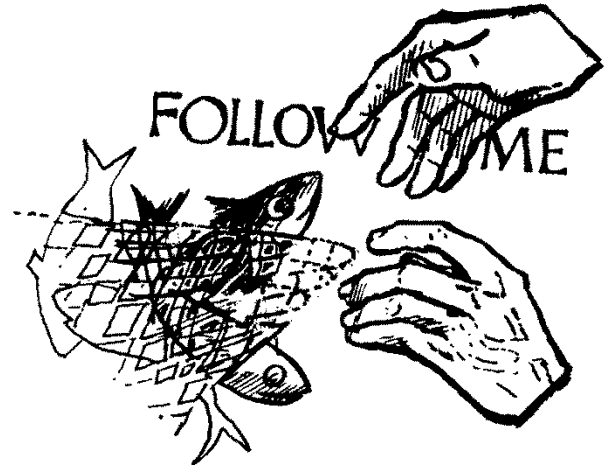

Holocaust Sunday The 27th January is the 75th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz and it is also Holocaust Memorial Day. In cities and towns across the United Kingdom, events will be held to mark this milestone in human history and to express the hope that such evil may never happen again.

This year, the theme chosen for Holocaust Memorial Day is "Stand Together". Those who are targeted by persecutors and racists find protection when others stand together in solidarity with them and challenge what is being done.
