**MOTHERING SUNDAY:** Mothering Sunday is the mid Lent Sunday, when we rejoice and relax our Lenten work of putting right any negligence's in our spiritual life. Its name comes from the habit of visiting our own mothers on this day, or the custom of visiting the Cathedral the 'mother' church of the diocese on that day. We pray for our own mothers, alive or dead, that they will be given the reward of their sacrifices for their families; we also pray for our Diocese as we wait our new bishop.
