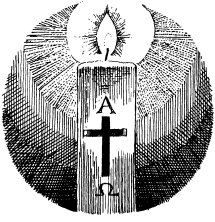

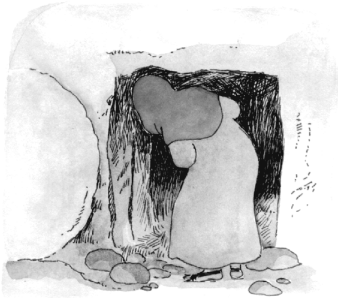


Jesus says: I am the light of the world. Whoever believes in me has the light of everlasting life.
