**ROSARY ON THE COAST - TODAY,** Our Lady of Lourdes Arnside this Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> April 3.00pm. **FREEDOM TO PRAY - FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION' PETITION.** Following Ealing Council's recent decision to impose a Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) to ban pro-lifers from staging prayer vigils close to the Marie Stopes clinic in the borough, a number of other local authorities are understood to be preparing to follow suit. SPUC has launched a major petition calling on the Home Secretary, Amber Rudd, to oppose any moves to restrict peaceful pro-life citizens' freedom of expression and freedom to pray outside abortion centres.
