Times of masses are: Arnside vigil mass Wednesday 5.30pm; Grange Thursday 10am, and Milnthorpe Thursday 7.00pm. *Jesus appeared for 40 days after His resurrection in his glorified body. Then He left this world in bodily form. He went away so that He could be available in all times and in all places spiritually to his faithful people; he is available today personally to give each of us purpose and hope on our journey through life.*
