- Showing our faithful that they are all 'Called and Gifted' personally as God's disciples to do unique work for the up-building of our church.

What is a PPC? The Parish Pastoral Councils (PPCs) do important work in overseeing and encouraging the activities and work of our parishes. The various groups in the parish report to this meeting. But their main duty is wider. They are to see that the pastoral remit of the parishes are carried out. They are to encourage evangelisation and the 'apostolate of the laity', in accordance with the mind of the church. The clergy are to 'cooperate with the laity' in encouraging the laity to do their apostolic work (Decree on the Apostolate of the Laity no.26) This is separate to the 'ministries' that are done by the laity to assist the clergy.
