**FINANCE NOTE – No 2, Some questions answered:** What does the Finance Group do?

Besides keeping a careful oversight of the finances and property, the Finance Group is trying to build a sound financial platform in the parish to meet anticipated and inevitable rising costs in the future rather than being forced into difficulty later by taking no action now.

**FINANCE NOTE – No 3,** Why increase income when we seem to be holding our own?

Sufficient regular giving is the only sure way of financing a parish

Why increase giving when we appear to have adequate capital funds? The capital we have needs to be reserved for major renewals and repairs to our properties, and should not be used as income. A family that does not earn a wage, but relies on a windfall win to live on, soon gets into trouble. The capital needs to be kept for 'a rainy day' in case of inevitable major expenditure.
