We are planning an all age family feel to the event with a music group from Capernwray College and an invitation to come early and have a picnic on the green first. **From 4.00pm** we will serve hot and cold drinks and there will be games for children with the KEY young people.

ST BENEDICT AND HYNING MONASTERY: We celebrate the feast of St Benedict on the 11th July. We remember Hyning in our prayers. The Cistercians, of which Hyning, are a reformed part of the Benedictine family.

CONFIDENT CATHOLICS: the group has finished discussing the set book 'Mere Christianity' by C S Lewis, and takes a break over the summer. The objective was modest: to remind ourselves that our Catholic and Christian faith is a rational option for intelligent people, in response to the dismissive and ignorant attitudes of some people to faith.

In the Autumn we are considering discussing the ground breaking document of Vatican II on the role of the laity ('Christ's Faithful'). This vital part of Vatican II has only partially been put into effect as yet. The church is considerably hampered in consequence as the laity do not realize that each person has a unique call and privilege to build up the kingdom of God in their place ('The apostolate of the laity')

ADOREMUS EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS: The Eucharist is the presence of Jesus among us. This is central to our faith. The last Congress was in 1908.

Representatives of our parishes will be attending this conference on the 7th-9th September. They are Shelagh Jackson, Barbara Hunter (Lead Person), Dcn Joe & Liz Pryzlucki, Mike Carter. There will be an introduction ceremony the week before in our churches on the 1st/2nd September and Barbara will speak about the Conference on the 15th/16th September. We are planning a reflection day for all our Eucharistic ministers, and any other s interested, shortly after, with a talk on the Congress.

FINANCE NOTES TO THE PARISH. SOME QUESTIONS ANSWERED:

What are the properties we need to renew and maintain?

We have two churches, a church hall, a house, and two business properties to maintain.

Why does our property income vary?

It can take some time and money to get a new tenant in to a property. In the meantime the empty property is a drain on parish resources.

How much capital do we have?

£130,000.00 approximately in investment accounts and £150,000.00 approximately in a current account.

Where did this capital come from?

Almost £200,000.00 came from legacies. Legacies are windfalls, which are unlikely to be repeated.

Where is our capital?

With the HSBC, but under the Diocesan Trust.

Why is it banked with the Diocese?

The Diocese and all the parishes. under English Law are one charity. We bank with them to keep our money within the charity.

Is it safe?

Yes. It is invested properly, and is held in our name by the Diocese. It is now impossible for the problems encountered several years ago to be repeated.

Does it earn income?

Yes, a small but significant amount of interest is earned on the bulk of the funds. The rest is in a current account.
