This Sunday 22nd July will be the last Children's Liturgy. We will reassemble on Sunday 9th September after the school holidays.

Christians Together. Our three linked churches cover three separate groupings of Christians Together. They are all moved to make real the great prayer of Our Lord that 'they should be one'. It is the duty of any Catholic to make contact with other Christians in a respectful way. This means first of all celebrating the common ground we hold together in all that conscience allows; learning about each other; respecting differences, praying for deeper unity and bearing a common witness as Christians.
