FINANCE NOTES TO THE PARISH. SOME QUESTIONS ANSWERED:

Can we use our funds as we want?

We can use up to £5000 per project without permission, but have to ask the Diocese if we want to spend more.

Why can't we get at all our capital immediately?

For Charitable reasons. The Diocese loans our money to other parishes that do not have capital and need funds to carry out necessary work. The Diocese acts like a banker, which loans the money put in by customers to others.

Can we get it in an emergency?

Yes. If suddenly needed, the Diocese would give us the money. But it would mean that another poorer parish without capital funds could not get the loan it needed.

Do we get any tax benefit?

The government helps us. If you pay tax and complete a simple Gift Aid statement, the government gives back the tax you paid on your giving. (see Gift Aid form) This year we received some £8,600 back. Our thanks here to David Alexander who administers the Gift Aid scheme
