Vocation & Bishop Paul led a day of recollection for clergy last week at Hynning. He spoke in a personal way of his call to be a Bishop, which came as a considerable shock and surprise. The papal nuncio even gave him a room to rest a few hours to get over the shock, before returning to Lancaster. But he stated that on reflection, this is but a continuation of the one call to follow Christ wherever he takes us. We too can reflect that following our call as Christians takes us to areas we did not imagine. Many never foresaw the call to be active grandparents when they thought of 'retirement'. He quoted a saying of his Bishop Emilio when in Zambia that 'only one who knows he or she is loved by the Lord' has enough love to be able to undertake the surprising twists of our Christian calling', (like being called to be Bishop!)

Mission Thought: Why are we thinking mission in our parishes? Pope Francis says: Each Christian and every community must discern the path the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey his call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach the 'peripheries' in need of the light of the gospel' (Evangelium Gaudium n. 20). Do we know anybody on the periphery of the church, perhaps in our own family? Fr. Philip

Our theme this year is Our Lady, Queen of Peace. Everyone is invited especially those who are sick.

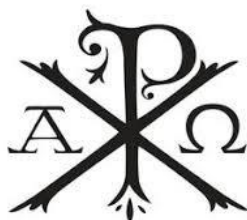
