The table will be replaced by something more compact so that the welcomers can do their apostolate without crowding in the people. The main entrance will continue to be used as before. BISHOP'S COAT OF ARMS: at a day of recollection for his clergy the Bishop explained his coat of arms. The Latin saying means 'holiness before peace'. There can be no true peace of heart unless we remain true to our call to follow God in conscience first (from Cardinal Newman). The ram caught in a thicket refers to the sacrifice of Isaac; God provided a ram as a substitute. We rely on His providence in difficult times for faith. The green and gold palms reminds us that faith transforms our ordinary lives, and makes what passes away like a leaf into something lasting and precious. Our faith is central.
