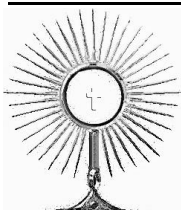

**EDUCATION SUNDAY** The Catholic Education Service (CES) acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conference to support Catholic education. They have a strong and positive working relationship with the British and Welsh Government, sharing the aims of high academic standards for all and increased parental choice.

**Catholic schools** make up 10% of the national total of maintained schools. There are more than 2200 Catholic schools, academies and colleges in England and Wales educating over 850,000 pupils. The Catholic Church and the Church of England together provide one-third of all of the schools in the country and account for 98% of all schools with a religious character.

**ADOREMUS EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS:** Takes place this weekend. This is the first Eucharistic Congress since 1909. It is an opportunity of stating a central belief of our Christian and Catholic faith that Jesus remains with us and for us in the Eucharist.

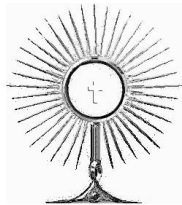

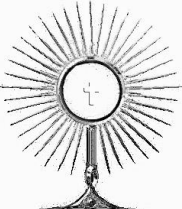

**ANOINTING AND HEALING SERVICE WITH BENEDICTION**, Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 3.00pm, at Grange followed by tea in the Magner room 3.45pm:



**The Eucharist and the anointing of the sick are connected.** In both these sacraments Jesus offers Himself for our healing. He heals us in mind and heart, so that we can face the realities of our state of health; he heals us morally so that we have the power to reform our lives and find inner peace; and, if He wills, he heals us physically where that is for our eternal good.  
**All of us are invited to this service.** The sacrament of the sick is for those who have some physical or mental illness, or who from old age need the power of God to help them.  
But we all need to be healed in some way, and to be given God's peace. As we say in the mass, before communion 'Lord I am not worthy to have you under my roof, only say the word and my soul shall be healed'. Would the housebound sign up the sheets in each church? Other parishioners from both our parishes are welcome, but need not sign up..

**CHURCH IMPROVEMENTS:** At Grange sound deadening shutters have been installed to the interior window between the Magner Room and the Church. They were made and fitted by Mr. Geoff Wainwright of Christ the King parish. We are very grateful for his work.  
The ladies at Christ the King are in the process of buying new altar linen and a new altar frontal in a neutral colour. This will do away with the constant need to strip the altar when the liturgical colour changes. The old cloths were looking a little worn and tired. As the new linen has a sacred purpose, it will be formally blessed and put on the altar in the near future, possibly the 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
