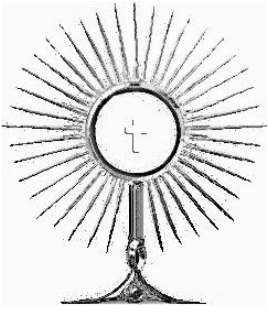

**Mapping Evangelisation** In 2019 the Home Mission office will be asking you to tell us how you are bringing the Joy of the Gospel to your local area. We want to hear what obstacles you have faced and how you deal with them so that we can help you in this vital ministry.

**Our Mission Group:** Is already reflecting on how to make the living presence of Jesus more truly present in our lives, the lives of our families and in our area. We had hoped to start an Alpha programme this Autumn, but this has been put back until after Christmas. The organization involved requires the extra time. **Alpha introduces people to a new and vital experience of Our Lord in their lives.** The intention is that as many as possible of the parish and all others invited or interested should have the opportunity of experiencing this programme. **Adoremus Eucharistic Congress:** Took place last weekend in Liverpool. This is the first Eucharistic Congress since 1909. It was a great success, with up to 10000 Catholics expressing their belief in the Eucharist as a central part of our Christian and Catholic faith. Jesus truly remains with us and for us in the Eucharist.

There were talks by several knowledgeable persons, including Archbishop Robert Barron who produced the 'Catholicism' series, and our own Sr. Margaret Atkins from Boarbank. There were also liturgies both in the arena and in the Metropolitan Cathedral and other places. We pray that the result will be a new impetus to re-state and live our fervent belief in the Eucharist.

Mrs Barbara Hunt of Grange, our main delegate, will try to sum up the Congress briefly after each Sunday mass.

**Day of Reflection for Eucharistic Ministers:** The day of reflection on the Eucharist and the Eucharistic Congress is at Boarbank this Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 10.00am to 3.00pm for both our parishes. It has a double purpose: to reflect on the Eucharistic Congress and it's meaning for us and also to reflect on the Ministry of Extraordinary Ministers of Communion. We will end up with a time of adoration in front of the Eucharist.
