### **CAFOD Family Fast Day: Friday 5 October**

On Family Fast Day, CAFOD invites us to share in the abundance that God has given us.

We are asked to fast, pray and give to help people like Longora, who lives in a remote village in Uganda.

The area is so hot and dry, people used to struggle to get enough clean water to survive. Thanks to the generosity of parishioners in England and Wales, CAFOD has made sure Longora and her neighbours now have a reliable supply of clean, safe water. On Family Fast Day (Friday 5 October), CAFOD invites us to eat simply - perhaps having a bowl of soup instead of a meal - and give the money we save to help people like Longora.

**Dedication of the Cathedral at Lancaster** is celebrated on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> October. The Cathedral is the mother church of the Diocese, the seat or 'Cathedra' of the Bishop. We thank God for the faith in our Diocese, and for the self-sacrifice of so many who have maintained our Diocese and parishes with all its structures and continue to do so now.

In the afternoon we heard from Deacon George Bissett about the Jewish thinking behind the mass. He spoke movingly of his journey into the church, drawn by the presence of Christ. We then thought a little about the spirituality of the Eucharistic Minister. Finally we ended with a short time before Our Lord, present in the Eucharist. Unfortunately the day was so compressed that we could not answer questions that were raised. **If you had any questions, please write them down and leave them in the sacristy of our various churches. They will be looked at when I return from holiday.** Thank you all for taking such trouble to attend the meeting.

**Shutters at Grange:** Many thanks to Mr Geoff Wainwright for building some sound deadening shutters for St Charles Grange. They close the window between the church and the Magner room. The purpose is to allow a social event to be carried on in the Magner room without disturbing the quiet in the church. They have served a good purpose already. They deadened the sound when our families gathered in the Magner room, while we were having a time of silent adoration before Sunday mass recently.
