November: the month of Saints & Holy Souls

November is the month when we remember the faithful departed. They exist in the land beyond our world. As Catholics we feel very close to them. They are just a prayer away; temporarily divided by the invisible veil we call death.

November Lists can be put before the altar during the month of November. Please take an envelope for the list of those you wish to remember and bring it back next week.

All Saints (Holyday of Obligation): November starts with a great statement of hope for the future in the feast of All Saints. We celebrate all the good people who have now fulfilled God's plan and have come home to Him in Heaven. We think first of all of the great saints outstating in holiness and witness to god. We also remember our call to be saints in heaven.

Masses : Vigil (Wednesday evening) 5.30pm Arnside; Thursday 10am Grange and 7.00pm at Milnthorpe.

All Souls On the feast of All Souls we remember all those who have not denied God, but who know they are not yet ready to see God face to face. We help them with our prayers to come to God in peace and joy (*see All Souls Indulgences*). Last year our Cemetery Service at Grange became a sort of meeting with old friends as we walked round the cemetery blessing graves. Mass of All Souls at 10.00am Milnthorpe; Cemetery Visit and graveside Service (meet 2.00pm Grange Cemetery entrance); and All Souls Memorial Service (not mass), 7.00pm Grange.

All Souls Indulgences: 'It is a fine and noble action (to pray for the dead)' (2 Maccabees 12:43)

In addition to the usual conditions (confession and communion about the time), a plenary indulgence applicable to only one of the Holy Souls, can be gained by making a devout visit to a church or oratory where an Our Father & Creed are said. The Indulgence can be gained on All Souls Day, the Sunday before or after, & All Saints Day, but only once.

CEMETERY INDULGENCE : In addition to the usual conditions, (confession and communion about the time), a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls, can be gained by a devout visit to a cemetery and praying there for the dead.
