**Christmas Masses:** Christmas falls on Tuesday this year. After careful thought and some consultation, I will keep the arrangement of last year. The Christmas masses will be: the Vigil mass, Milnthorpe, 7.00pm Monday; the day masses at Grange 9.30am and at Arnside at 10.30am. Thanks to Mgr. Slattery for taking the Arnside mass, and enabling this arrangement to take place.

**Grange: Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)** meets this Wednesday 7.30pm after mass. The purpose of the Council is to advise the Parish priest on pastoral policy and other matters, to receive reports of various activities in the parish, and to give encouragement to this work. An Annual General Meeting open to parishioners is held each year to sum up the work of the Council for the past year and to hear any propositions and comments from the parish. The AGM for Milnthorpe and Arnside is on the 7<sup>th</sup> December. The AGM for Grange has yet to be decided.

**Grange, Feast of St. Charles:** this Sunday

St Charles was born October 2, 1538, at Arona, duchy of Milan and died November 3, 1584, Milan; canonized 1610; feast day November 4, a cardinal and archbishop who was one of the most important figures of the Counter-Reformation in Italy.

Saint Charles spent his life and fortune in the service of the people of his diocese. He directed and fervently enforced the decrees of the Council of Trent, fought tirelessly for peace in the wake of the storm caused by Martin Luther, founded schools for the poor, seminaries for clerics, hospitals for the sick, conducted synods, instituted children's Sunday school, did great public and private penance, and worked among the sick and dying, leading his people by example.

A picture of St. Charles is being bought, and we hope it be blessed at next Sunday mass at Grange.
